

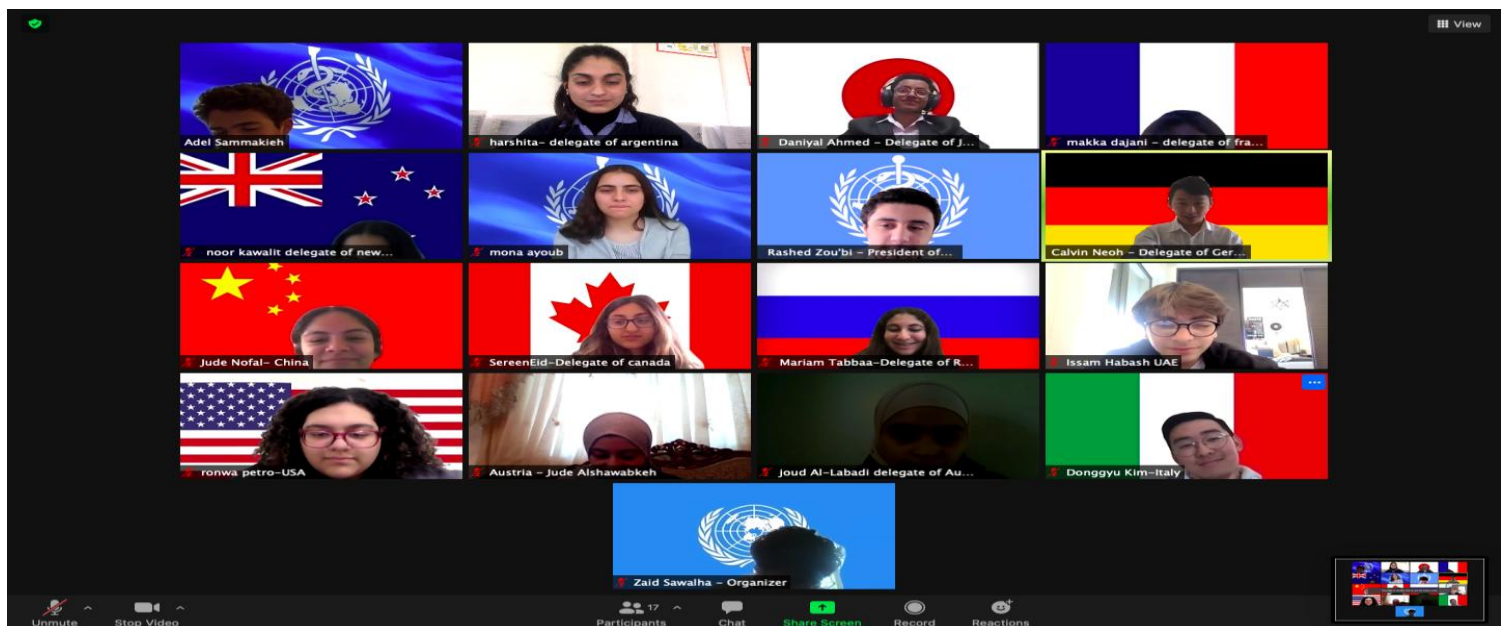


KAMUN '21
