### Sanawar lends helping hand to needy in fight against Covid-19

Notwithstanding the necessity and significance of country wide lockdown to counter the crisis of coronavirus pandemic, the lockdown is also causing livelihood crisis, especially for BPL family and migrant daily wagers. Responding to this crisis faced by most vulnerable sections of its neighbouring communities, The Lawrence School, Sanawar, distributed dry ration to over 100 migrant labourers. School headmaster, Himmat Singh Dhillon, handed over packs of dry ration to the poor labourers. Besides masks, sanitizers and soaps, the dry ration pack included 10 kg rice, 5 kg atta, 3 kg cooking oil, 3 kg sugar, 2 kg salt and 3 kg lentils (dal). In the presence of Garhwal-Sanawar Parichayat pradhan, Rajendra Sharma, who helped identify the needy people, daily wagers originally belonging to places as far as Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Rajasthan, Bihar, Odisha received the ration. The school headmaster extended his heartiest thanks to president of the Old Sanawarian Society, Major General Kulpreet Singh (Retd.) and the entire Old Sanawarian fraternity for the unflinching support. The occasion was used to create awareness among people regarding maintenance of good hygiene to prevent the spread of covid-19.

poor labourers, majority being female, is expected to ease their food crisis at least for next two to three days. Besides masks, sanitizers and soaps, the dry ration pack included 10 kg Atta, 5 kg Rice, 2 kg cooking oil, 3 kg sugar, 2 kg salt and 3 kg lentils (dal). The daily wagers who received the dry ration pack were migrant workers from places as far as Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Rajasthan, Bihar, Odisha, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal. Some of these distressed daily wagers included sweepers, petty vendors, construction workers, garbage pickers, and even 200 migrant labourers who are among the most vulnerable in its neighbouring communities. The headmaster of the school, Himmat Singh Dhillon, the president of the Old Sanawarian Society, Major General Kulpreet Singh (Retd.), and the entire Old Sanawarian fraternity for the unflinching support. The occasion was used to create awareness among people regarding maintenance of good hygiene to prevent the spread of covid-19.
