A team from the Rashtrya Life Saving Society (India) conducted a workshop on Basic First Aid and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation for 260 students and 60 staff members of the Lawrence School, Sanawar, which also included support staff, from the 26th – the 28th of this month.

The Lawrence School Sanawar, has with RLSS(I), been empowering the School Community with safety awareness and skills to help accident or trauma victims since the last four years.

The students, as part of the School 'Outreach Program', have been conducting First Aid and CPR awareness programs among the local schools like Saraswati Niketan School Kasauli, Govt. High Garkhal, Govt. High School Chamia, Govt. Sr. Secondary School Kanda and Govt. Sr. Secondary School Dharampur. Some of the students from these schools have been attended this workshop conducted by RLSS(I), free of cost at Sanawar.



India loses approximately one million lives due to accidents on land and in water every year and has more than four million permanently disabled people as a result of these accidents.

Fifty percent of these lives could have been saved had the victims received prompt First Aid and emergency help.
