SEEPED IN HISTORY A LEGACY IN ITSELF

Founded by Sir Henry and Lady Honoria Lawrence, Sanawar is believed to be the first co-educational residential school in the world. On the 19th of April 1967 a group of 14 boys and girls camped at the top of a spur in the foothills of the Himalayas. Sanawar came into being by 1953 the first of the School buildings had come up under the able guidance of Major William Holden and grew to 195 students and was powered by the King Colour. Sanawar has held its Colour for the longest continuous period. Sanawar's centenary year (1967) was a major milestone of students and staff to UK and Sanawar passed from the Crown to the Government of India. Ministry of Education and further on to the autonomous Lawrence School (Sanawar) Society. The School continued to evolve and modernize throughout the middle and later years of the last century. The first principal of School was Mr. R. J. Parker and the first Indian Headmaster Major Sam Dutt laid the foundation for the School as it is today. ETHOS-A WAY OF LIFE

Sanawar is a close knit community where each one shares a strong bond of camaraderie and genuine concern for one another. Our School motto NEVER GIVE IN encompasses the spirit of Sanawar. From Academics, to Sports and Co-curricular activities, a Sanawarian does it all. A typical student at Sanawar is in busy as he is learning the day with an early morning routine 5.45 followed by physical education, class (one-on-one) and hobbies and sports (post-lunch) to wind it up with Evening Prep and Study Hour. The weekends are for more creative and special pursuits like House Shows (cultural, functional), debates, declamations, MUN, Club meetings, quizzes, Community service projects etc. Modern offered range from Art, Sculpture, Paper Recycling, Weaving, Woodwork, Indian and Western Music, Indian Dance, Fashion Designing, Cooking, Photography, Chess. Located close to the picturesque hill station of Kisumu, on a rare hillock at 5,000ft, forested with pine and evergreens, Sanawar has developed over 100 acres and is now a historical landmark in its own right. With its characteristic rock visible on the horizon, the estate is a veritable wilderness of winding paths, trees, fountains and waterfalls. On a clear day one has a panoramic view of the snow clad mighty Himalayas to the North. Away from the distractions of city life, Sanawarian interests are concentrated within its idyllic environment. Amongst its many historic buildings are Redwood Academic block, the School Chapel built in 1937, Parker Hall (School library and messengers' mess), Central Dining Hall and Cavalry Hall (Boys Gym Hall) Moving on with contemporary times the entire campus has internet access and internal communication.



The School is affiliated to the CBSE (New Delhi) and comprises of Classes 5 to 12. The student strength is approximately 750 students and the teaching faculty comprises of over 70 members. Subject streams offered to Class XII students are Humanities, Commerce with and without Mathematics, Science (PCM & PCB). There is ample pastoral care and support staff to take good care of students in the dormitories and other living areas. A well-equipped hospital with a resident Medical Doctor ensures best of health care to the Sanawarian community.

PEDAGOGIES IN PLAY

Teenagers and Young Adults learn differently, using their multiple intelligences. Therefore, our program builds Value-Based Leadership Skills using multiple pedagogies and most significantly, Reading-and-Case Studies-based self-reflection. The programme has the following key sub-modules and pedagogies organized to ensure variety and versatility.

- 1. Scientific Dialogue:** Scientific Dialogues are video-mediated group discussions which use question-based, problem-solving decisions to provide a common context for a disciplined reflection. It is both a form of enquiry and debate to stimulate critical thinking. Students watch our carefully selected movie clips, with a powerful message to personal and social development for the purpose.
- 2. Leadership Case Studies:** Students can leadership case studies to analyze and reach conclusions based on the facts, conflicting perspectives and the impact on people and organizations. Case studies are the preferred way of teaching-learning in all business schools.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

A. The TSLP is a leadership programme by The Lawrence School, Sanawar with Agnes (www.agnes.org.uk) for students of CBSE & IB. To build their leadership skills, enable them to meet their future as leaders and to service the school mission as an institution of excellence, students' personality before the time.
- Q. What does TSLP track include?**
A. The programme includes:
• Basic leader knowledge (developed through dialogue & experience that leaders can be developed, groomed and mentored).
• Built-in awareness of the social context, priority and goals with the energy and an responsibility towards them.
• Develop self-lead recognition of the pros & cons of leadership of a great leader. Recognize that decisions made under pressure from the school, business leadership.

• Encourage vulnerability through opportunity for discussing emotions and feelings, increasing through personal coaching.
- Q. Why do we need to change?**
