NOTES.

1. Preference is given to children of British soldiers serving with the Army in India.
2. Children are not accepted under the age of five years.
3. Children are accepted for admission on the understanding that they will remain for the whole year, preferably longer, unless leave, transfer, or other unforeseen circumstances compel the parents to withdraw the child earlier.
4. Children whose fathers are on the active list of the Regular Army will not be admitted, unless the agreement relating to pay is signed.
5. Children whose fees are more than two months in arrears are liable to be returned to their parents at the latter's expense.
6. Parents and guardians wishing to remove a child from the School must give fourteen days' notice of their intention, in writing, to the Principal, accompanied by a remittance of the amount due on account of the child to the date of removal.
7. The orders under which free passages are granted for children and their guardians proceeding to and from Sanawar are given in A 1 (I) 6 of January, 1942.

Children are ineligible for admission if they are idiotic or subject to some disease or infirmity which will render education impossible, or very difficult, or which may hereafter hinder them from earning their livelihood.

Illness is not necessarily a bar to admission but the Principal expects to be informed of it.

It is desirable that a Birth or Baptismal Certificate should accompany this application if available.

Information is required in the case of orphans; the Principal will supply the details if asked.

Children are eligible for a pension after admission to the School, the parent or guardian must report the fact to the Principal immediately the pension is awarded.

Children will not be admitted without transfer certificates. Children from other schools must bring their record books to Sanawar on first joining.

Parents must notify the Principal of all promotions or increases in income immediately they occur.
