5. Parents and guardians wishing to remove a child from the School must give fourteen days' notice of their intention, in writing, to the Principal, accompanied by a remittance of the amount due on account of the child to the date of removal.
6. The orders under which free passages are granted for children and their guardians proceeding to and from Sanawar, are given in A II 114 of 1937.
7. A child is ineligible for admission if it is idiotic or subject to some disease or infirmity which will render education impossible, or very difficult, or which may hereafter hinder candidates from earning their livelihood.
Illegitimacy is not necessarily a bar to admission but the Principal expects to be informed of the fact.
8. It is highly desirable that a Birth or Baptismal Certificate should accompany this application if such is available.
9. Additional information is required in the case of orphans; the Principal will supply the necessary details if asked.
10. If a child becomes eligible for a pension after admission to the School, the parent or guardian must report the fact to the Principal immediately the pension is awarded.


