2018

 Our School English Debating Team comprising Jaiveer Singh, Esha Malhotra and AvantiAggarwal participated in the Inter-School English Debates held at Vivek High School, Chandigarh on 9th and 10th of August, 2018. Fourteen teams participated and there were 3 rounds.

In the Preliminary Round, Sanawar debated against Strawberry Fields High School, Chandigarh and won the debate. Jaiveer Singh was declared the Best Speaker of the entire Preliminary Round (Best among all 14 teams). In the Second Round (Semi Finals), Sanawar debated against the host school and won.
